Lane Gebers from Fellowship United Methodist Church is serving as the Project Manager and will be coordinating the build with us. Lane is the president of Frontier Basement Systems and will also be donating the insulation and the installation of the insulation to the project.

The ground-breaking ceremony was held on Saturday May 6th and the footers were dug and poured this past week by James Hembre from Mount Carmel United Methodist Church. Smyrna Ready Mix donated the concrete for the footers.

We don't currently have a licensed plumber to do the initial rough plumbing, a block layer or the materials for the foundation. However, Bob Frost from Trinity Episcopal Church has a lead on someone that may be able to do the block work and hopes to have that nailed down in the next few days.

Our parish will be doing the framing when the time comes. We hope that this will happen in the next three to four weeks.

The family for whom we are building the house has had some bad luck this past couple of weeks. They were packing up to move out of their current rental house and the house caught on fire. All her belongings were destroyed in the fire. We are trying to get this project completed with a renewed sense of urgency so that the family can get in the house as soon as possible. Near the end of the project, we will try to put a list of furniture that she may need and have each of the churches contribute something to help them get settled.
