94.9 WGIC Low Power FM is broadcast from the antenna in the steeple of this Chapel of Immaculate Conception Church, dedicated in 1880. For 137 years the Gospel of Jesus Christ has been proclaimed in and from this sacred space. The sacrifice of Holy Eucharist is offered here on weekdays, Confessions are heard on Saturdays, and most of the parish's weddings and funerals are celebrated here. It seems appropriate, then, for Catholic radio to go forth from this highest part of our campus.

Most of our programming is provided by Eternal Word Radio, EWTN. Immaculate Conception Church and School will also be broadcasting prayers, hymns, homilies, and more.

Amen.

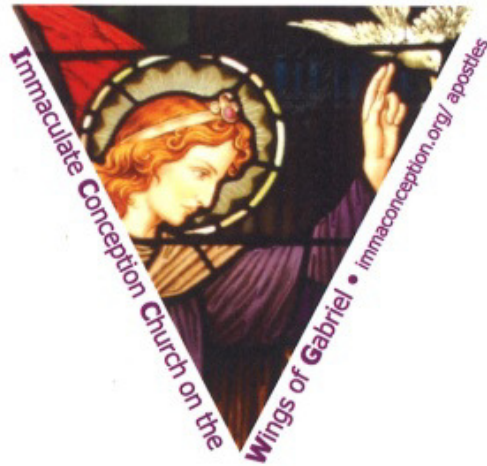

Immaculate Conception Church *on the Wings of Gabriel*

On August 28, 2013, Fr. David Gaffny, Pastor, asked Most Rev. David Choby, Bishop of Nashville, for permission to petition the Federal Communications Commission for a license for a Low Power FM radio station in Clarksville.

Fr. David signed a five-year contract with EWTN on December 18, 2014. At the outset, all of our programming is provided by Eternal Word (EWTN) radio. Our agreement is that we may use our own or other programming for up to 20 percent of the broadcast time, most of it on weekends.

The equipment was installed in the Summer of 2016 and we were ready for an antenna tower. The decision was made to install the antenna inside the steeple of the Old Chapel.

On Monday, January 9, 2017, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we began testing the broadcast of the new Low Power parish radio station.

On Thursday, January 26, 2017, the Memorial of Saints Timothy & Titus, the FCC granted our license.

In the Summer of 2017 the parish contracted with Duncan Morrow for assistance with weekly monitoring and daily audio and managing parish programming, and Fr. Steve Wolf began to record a series of Catholic prayers.

In September, 2017 WGIC became available anywhere online, through **www.shoutcast.com**, which can be accessed through the parish web site, **www.immaconception.org**. On mobile devices, visit your app store for the free SHOUTCAST app, and search for WGIC.

WGIC is a member of the Catholic Radio Association.
